By Bus

The Ulster Hospital is served by the by a regular metro service. The 4A and 20A service runs regularly from Belfast City Centre to the front entrance of the Hospital. Ulsterbus Services running between Belfast and Newtownards also stop at the front entrance of the hospital.

Translink also wish to note that County Down passengers are set to benefit from a new direct Ulsterbus coach service from Portaferry to Belfast from the beginning of September.

By Car

The Hospital is situated on the Upper Newtownards Rd. This makes the hospital easily accessible to both Belfast (via the Newtownards Rd, Knock Rd, Hawthorndon Way and the A55 off the Sydenham bypass) and Newtownards (via Kempe Stones Rd).

The Hospital is also accessible from the south via the Comber Rd and the East Road Link. There is a rear entrance to the hospital accessible via Stoney Rd. If travelling by car please allow time to park and walk to the appropriate facility.
